ALBUQUERQUE-- La Casa Teatro will present the opening of Rudolfo Anaya's *Angie*, a bilingual play about an elderly Hispanic woman who moves out of her barrio home and into a retirement center, beginning July 10 at the South Broadway Cultural Center.

Angie, a comic drama, is one of several collaborative efforts between director, Cecilia Aragon and playwright Rudolfo Anaya. When forced into the nursing home, Angie forms new relationships, revisits her youth and confronts her future...La muerte. Angie is brought to life by Liz Martinez who is a long time Albuquerque musician and actress. The supporting cast includes Rosalie Trianni, Omar Trujillo, Fernando Lucero, John DeBois, and Marcos Morales.

On July 10, A free Senior Citizen show is scheduled at 10:00 am and the opening GALA and book signing is at 6:00 p.m., following a performance at 7:30 p.m. Additional general admission performances will be on July 11th, 17th (book signing) and 18th, at 7:30 p.m. and July 12th and 19th at 2:00 p.m. Ticket prices are \$8.00 for adults and \$5.00 for seniors and children.
